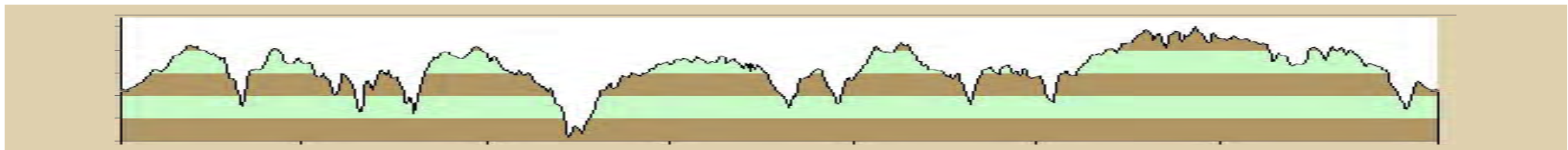
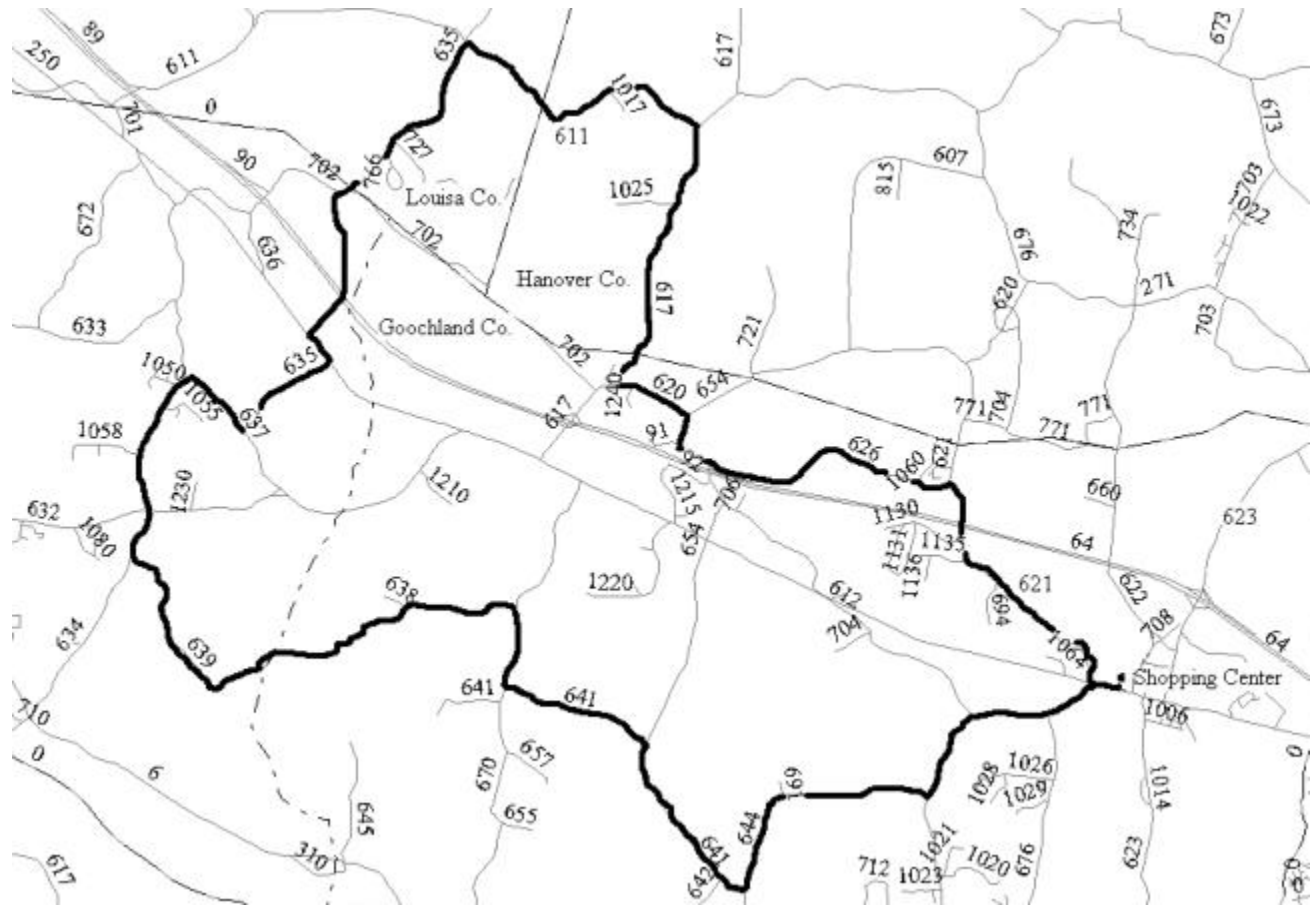

Description: Meet in the Food Lion parking lot (towards the rear) at Broad View Shopping Center for a ride into northern Goochland County horse country. Long ago, club riders encountered some of the area's friendlier dogs on this route and named the ride in their honor. The route is divided into two distinct halves by route 250. The terrain consists of rolling hills. There is no store stop so bring water and snacks.

Directions: To get to Centerville, take I-64 west of Richmond to the Rockville/Manakin exit, then south on 623 about a mile, to a right on Rt. 250 a short distance and you'll see the shopping center on your right. Alternatively, if you come out West Broad Street (Rt 250), the shopping center is on your right about 1.5 miles west of the Rt 288 interchange.

Route Notes:

Route:

- Clockwise loop divided by Rt 250; mostly Goochland, some Louisa & Hanover
- Terrain is hilly, more so in the first half
- Tailwind on second half
- No store stop
- Confusing intersections in Perkinsville (mile ~21); stay on 635

Hazards:

- Two short sections on Rt 250 (traffic)

Sights/history:

- Horse farms
- Beautiful mansions, esp. @ ~ 1.5 mi
