15 & 28 mile rides (32 with Great Island loop)

START: Salt Pond Shopping Center, Rt. 108 in Narragansett, RI

15 miles: left at second light after the towers

28 miles: straight after the towers


32 miles: do the Great Island loop (turn right at Galilee)

SCENIC NOTES

This ride explores RI's southern coast to Pt. Judith, the fishing village of Galilee & the Narragansett beaches. from Wakefield, head south to Galilee & Great island. The Block Island Ferry is along the route & a visit to the Island may make for a great day trip in your future. Sand Hill Cove Beach & the Pt. Judith Coast Guard Station are open to the public. The run to the north along the coast to Narragansett Pier includes Scarborough Beach, views of the rocky coastline & the cedar homes which overlook the ocean. The ride goes under the stone arch of the Towers, (designed by Stanford White) & by an Indian sculpture. South County Museum is just off Strathmore & is an interesting stop for a history lesson of this area.
