



Pomfret Air Line State Park Trail

Trail Highlights

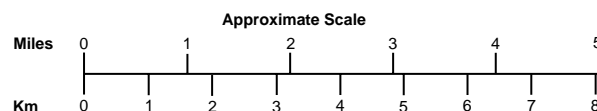
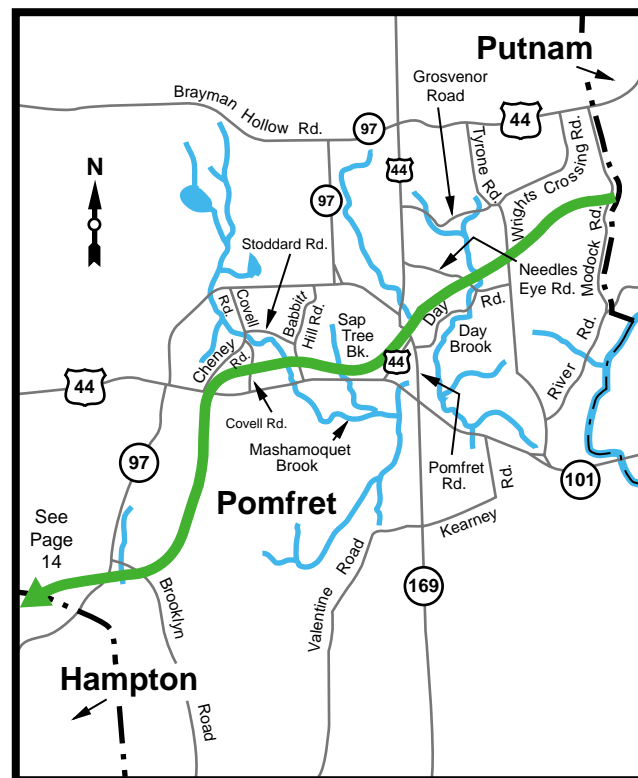
This trail is part of the 50-mile Air Line State Park Trail that begins in East Hampton and ends in Putnam. This 8-mile section of the trail begins at the Hampton town line, where it connects with Hampton's portion of the trail. The trail then continues for 1.3 miles where it crosses Route 97 then Brooklyn Road, and then continues 2.2 miles until it passes under Route 44. Over the next 2.5 miles the trail intersects Covell Road, Babbitt Hill Road, Route 169 (Route 44) as well as many small brooks, then crosses Wrights Crossing Road, before ending at the Putnam town line and Modock Road. The Air Line State Park Trail has not been improved east of this point, but is planned to run into Putnam to the Putnam River Trail.

Parking and Accessibility

No designated parking area is available for trail users. (For parking see the Hampton section of the trail, page 14.)

From Route 44 East: Follow Route 44 to Cheney Road. The trail can be accessed from this intersection.

From Route 44 West: Take a right onto Wrights Crossing Road, located at the Putnam/Pomfret town line. The trail can be accessed from this road.
